



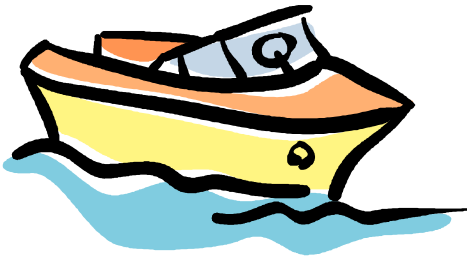

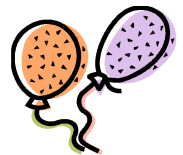

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION TO MEMBERS: PLEASE READ

ZYC MEMBERS HELP REQUESTED

Weed eating around the trailers & boats that are on land. We pay to have the grounds mowed & general trimming on the property. However trimming around trailers & boats that are on ground are a different issue. No boat owner wants grass stains & dead weeds all over their boat or damage from equipment too close to their boat or trailer. We do not want to be responsible for any damage to a trailer or boat from lawn mowing & trimming equipment. However we do not want unsightly weeds growing 10 feet high around that area either. It makes the property in that area look like a junk shipyard. It is your responsibility to keep the area near your boat or trailer maintained. That goes for blocks, hoses, plastic bottles, wood & other materials laying around your designated area. If it is not maintained then we will trim & clean up your area & an additional fee will be accessed at the end of your term. Members who want to help their fellow ZYC member who may not be able to keep up with this task can help by trimming or mowing around these areas as well.

Members are asked to please help keep entire grounds clean. If you see trash on the property please help to dispose of it. If trash containers in the bathrooms or clubhouse need emptied it is much appreciated by all if members would help do this. As mentioned before the cleaning man we have is paid by the hour & the less he has to do the more money the club saves. The more money the club can save...Then the less members have to pay on dues.

Since we are not going to rely on extra income from general public clubhouse rentals we will evaluate the cost of expenses for cleaning, mowing, supplies, etc. & re-visit our the cost of our current dues. Our dues are the most reasonable of any Yacht Club that I know of for what we get. I would be very happy to keep it that way if all the members lend an extra hand from time to time and keep our cost down.

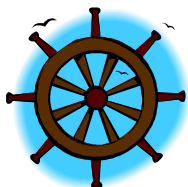
