CLUBHOUSE RENTAL POLICY: The trustees have agreed to keep price to general public at **\$500.00** with a \$100.00 refund if left in clean condition. Club Members can rent for **\$200.00** for **immediate family only and members must be present**. No extra days to decorate and clean up unless you pay for it. All rental requests must be presented in writing or by email to trustees for approval. **THIS IS A PRIVATE CLUB AND WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE REQUESTS TO GENERAL PUBLIC FOR ANY REASON.** Decisions for members requests is based on scheduling, type of party and number attending.

INFORMATION ABOUT PRIVATE PARTIES: This means that someone, either a member or not, has reserved the clubhouse for a party. That does not mean that members are not permitted around. It just means that we respect the individuals having their event & we don't interfere with their function. However as members we always have the right to bathroom facilities, the docks & a member's only area just south of the clubhouse. If you have any questions about this arrangement just brush up a bit on your club policy manual or of course ask any one of the trustees.

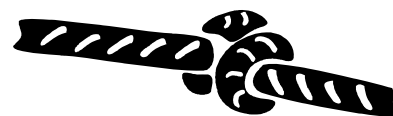

2012 TRUSTEES MEETING COMMITTEE CHAIRS & REPORTS

FINANCE COMMITTEE: Maggie Collins reported to the board our account balance, noted that all bills are paid and that the club is in great financial shape for the new year. If any members want to know more details of the accounting of the club please attend the Installation Banquet where we will give a complete report of our clubs standing. Also if anyone is interested in helping Maggie with the finance committee please contact us and let us know. I am sure Maggie can use some help from time to time.

FUND RAISING: Jeff Miller reported that our next big fund raiser will be the 2nd annual Salty Dog Golf outing at the Clubhouse again and we will have a combined Chicken Roast & Golf Outing on July 7th. This will be the Saturday after July 4th. We will extend the course to 18 holes of golf this year and the dinner will be the Chicken Roast we usually have on the 4th of July. Since the 4th occurs on a Wednesday this year we thought it would workout better to have the Golf Outing and the Chicken Roast the Saturday after the 4th. Since the Muskingum Valley Boaters Association has dropped their Poker Run and question whether they will do this again, it might be an opportunity for us to try this as one of our fund raisers. Anyone who wants to serve on this committee or has any ideas of a fund raising event or function please let Jeff know.

GROUNDS: Mike Fisher reported that the fence is up in the front part of our property close to Linden and is preventing people from driving on our property and leaving large ruts in the yard. This was completed by our own "John Henry"...Commodore Jeff Hardwick and with the help of Butch Collins' tools and garage. Commodore Jeff also painted the ZYC on our gate sign. He said he liked the "Key West Blue" and hopes everyone else does as well. It will be much like the one at the left of the driveway coming in to the clubhouse. The new **shed** is in place and will have electric and work benches inside. Decorations and other building supplies currently in the clubhouse showers can be stored in this shed. The lawn mower and other outside tools will be stored in the old shed. Mike also wanted to remind everyone to PLEASE take your trash to the dumpsters. No trash is to be left at the tent area or at the patio area. That is why there are no trash containers outside. It draws rodents and coons. If anyone has any ideas on ways to improve our grounds or wants to serve on this committee please contact Mike.

BUILDING: Dave Page reported that Coat racks or hooks will be installed in the hallway going to bathrooms. Also a new cork board may be put up for members use. The other cork board is to be used for club announcements & not for personal use by members. This new cork board can be used by members & the other will be controlled by the board. It should go without saying but ..."keep it clean" when posting something on the new board. Dave also reported that the new coca cola beverage machine is working out fine as well as the cooler inside. Clubhouse Rentals are available to members at the same price as last year at \$200.00. General Public can rent for \$400 with a \$100 deposit. As promised before, the trustees will not over book the clubhouse and we will keep dates open for our members during holiday weekends and special events. The new refrigerator w/ freezer & stove for kitchen are a nice addition to the kitchen as well. PLEASE remember to help with taking out trash in clubhouse as well. Fruit flies are a nuisance and will multiply rapidly if trash is left in clubhouse too long. Anyone who would like to assist Dave with building duties and lend a hand can please contact him.

DOCKS : Jay Fisher and committee will be updated the electric service on the docks with new "quick connects" electrical wiring. This will most likely be a three year project due to the expense but hope to have a few new connects each year and all to be done within 3 years. The Dock Assignments have been put together and those who are docking should have signed Dock Slip Agreements. If you are considering dockage please see Jay so he can put you on the list. We have Dock Rules, Regulations & a Dock Lease Agreement that must be filled out if you dock. We did have some damage to the docks when a tree fell across them just north of clubhouse. Electric is intact & docks are secured. As soon as "Kroffty" is freed up from all the tree service he will stop down & clean things up.

PLEASE NOTE: We do have a "Courtesy Area" for our members. It is just a space north and a space & 1/2 south of the Ramp. We will have new signs posted soon. PLEASE OBEY THE RULES OF THIS AREA. If you are not sure of the rules, read your Policy Manual or ask a trustee. Anyone wanting to help Jay & his committee please let him know.

PUBLIC RELATIONS: Jeff Hardwick has completed the promotional brochure to be used for membership recruitment. It is posted on the website and we will have copies at the clubhouse. If anyone would need some brochures to help promote the club and get some new members signed up just let Jeff know. We will have extras. The Web site is constantly updated & we are also very involved with the new "MRAC" Muskingum River Advisory Council. This council tries to involve representatives from all areas of the River from Coshocton to Marietta to use our resources & ideas for River Improvements. We also will be involved in the River Clean Up day that several organizations come together to help clean up the river & its banks. Beth Bronkar is continuing to do the Newsletter and doing a great job. If anyone has something they want to put in the newsletter please let Beth or one of the trustees know. Also if anyone has any ideas about PR, Website or anything that will help to promote the club please give Jeff or a trustee a call. We can use all the help we can get.

ZYC INVESTMENT GROUP: As you all should know by now that by purchasing 52% of the land that surround the Yacht Club we also have become an integral part of the Zanesville Investment Group. We have renewed the Farm Lease of our land to Bell Farms this year so it will be business as usual. It is soy bean this year. Dave Page is the new president, Jim Crowley is treasurer with Becky Mitzel serving as secretary. The entire board of trustees serve on this committee and make decisions as a whole group along with the rest of the Investors.

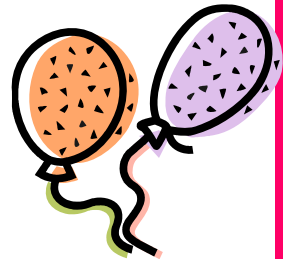

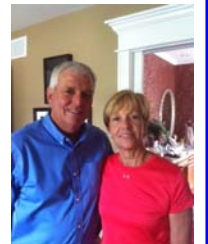
HAPPY WEDDING ANNIVERSARY
