**CLUBHOUSE RENTAL POLICY:** The trustees have agreed to keep price to general public at **\$500.00** with a \$100.00 refund if left in clean condition. Club Members can rent for **\$200.00 for immediate family only and members must be present.** No extra days to decorate and clean up unless you pay for it. All rental requests must be presented in writing or by email to trustees for approval. **THIS IS A PRIVATE CLUB AND WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REFUSE REQUESTS TO GENERAL PUBLIC FOR ANY REASON.** Decisions for members requests is based on scheduling, type of party and number attending.

**INFORMATION ABOUT PRIVATE PARTIES:** This means that someone, either a member or not, has reserved the clubhouse for a party. That does not mean that members are not permitted around. It just means that we respect the individuals having their event & we don't interfere with their function. However as members we always have the right to bathroom facilities, the docks & a member's only area just south of the clubhouse. If you have any questions about this arrangement just brush up a bit on your club policy manual or of course ask any one of the trustees.

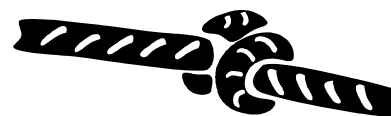

## **2012 TRUSTEES MEETING COMMITTEE CHAIRS & REPORTS**

**FINANCE COMMITTEE:** Maggie Collins reported to the board our account balance, noted that all bills are paid and that the club is in great financial shape for the new year. If any members want to know more details of the accounting of the club please attend the Installation Banquet where we will give a complete report of our clubs standing. Also if anyone is interested in helping Maggie with the finance committee please contact us and let us know. I am sure Maggie can use some help from time to time.

**FUND RAISING:** Jeff Miller reported that our next big fund raiser will be the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual Salty Dog Golf outing at the Clubhouse again and we will have a combined Chicken Roast & Golf Outing on July 7<sup>th</sup>. This will be the Saturday after July 4<sup>th</sup>. We will extend the course to 18 holes of golf this year and the dinner will be the Chicken Roast we usually have on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. Since the 4<sup>th</sup> occurs on a Wednesday this year we thought it would workout better to have the Golf Outing and the Chicken Roast the Saturday after the 4<sup>th</sup>. Anyone who wants to serve on this committee or has any ideas of a fund raising event or function please let Jeff know.

**GROUNDS:** Mike Fisher reported that we will be putting up a fence in the front part of our property close to Linden to prevent people from driving on our property out front and leaving large ruts in the yard. It will be much like the one at the left of the driveway coming in to the clubhouse. The new **shed** is in place and will have electric and work benches inside. Decorations and other building supplies currently in the clubhouse showers can be stored in this shed. The lawn mower and other outside tools will be stored in the old shed. Mike and committee had a company sandblast and professionally paint the front gate. It looks great. We will be painting the "ZYC" logo blue and adding reflectors when the paint cures. If anyone has any ideas on ways to improve our grounds or wants to serve on this committee please contact Mike.

**BUILDING:** Dave Page reported that coat racks or hooks will be installed in the hallway going to bathrooms. Also a new cork board may be put up for members use. The other cork board is to be used for club announcements and not for personal use by members. This new cork board can be used by members and the other will be controlled by the board. It should go without saying but ..."keep it clean" when posting something on the new board.

Dave also reported that we have a new beverage machine...No it's not a beer machine...It is a coca cola beverage machine. Our Pepsi one was taken back by the local company along with our cooler because of what they say..."Lack of Usage". They had reported that only a few cases were used in over two years. We know this was not the case but our argument held no weight up against the colorful charts and reports that were given to the Pepsi Office. Oh well. So we called the local Coke representative and they gave us a new machine and a new cooler in the Kitchen to use. **THANK YOU!!!**

Clubhouse Rentals are available to members at the same price as last year at \$200.00. General Public can rent for \$400 with a \$100 deposit. As promised before, the trustees will not over book the clubhouse and we will keep dates open for our members during holiday weekends and special events. We also purchased a refrigerator w/ freezer and stove for kitchen. They are not brand new but are better than what we have been using. If anyone would like to assist Dave with building duties and lending a hand, please contact him.

**DOCKS :** Jay Fisher and committee will be updating the electric service on the docks with new "quick connects" electrical wiring. This will most likely be a three year project due to the expense but hope to have a few new connects each year and all to be done within 3 years. The Dock Assignments have been put together and those who are docking should have signed Dock Slip Agreements. If you are considering dockage please see Jay so he can put you on the list. We have Dock Rules, Regulations & a Dock Lease Agreement that must be filled out if you dock.

**PUBLIC RELATIONS:** Jeff Hardwick has completed the promotional brochure to be used for membership recruitment. It is posted on the website and we will have copies at the clubhouse. We also have over 1000 printed up and were sent out to Chamber of Commerce members in a direct mailer at the end of April. If anyone would need some brochures to help promote the club and get new members signed up just let Jeff know. We will have extras. The Website is constantly updated and we are also very involved with the new "MRAC" Muskingum River Advisory Council. This council tries to involve representatives from all areas of the River from Coshocton to Marietta to use our resources and ideas for River Improvements. We also will be involved in the River Clean Up day that several organizations come together to help clean up the river and its banks. If anyone has any ideas about PR, Website or anything that will help to promote the club please give Jeff a call. He can use all the help he can get.

**ZYC INVESTMENT GROUP:** As you all should know by now that by purchasing 52% of the land that surrounds the Yacht Club we also have become an integral part of the Zanesville Investment Group. We have renewed the Farm Lease of our land to Bell Farms this year so it will be business as usual. It was corn last year so I am thinking it will be soy bean this year. Tom Colopy is President, Jim Crowley is Treasurer with Becky Mitzel serving as Secretary. The entire board of trustees serve on this committee and make decisions as a whole group along with the rest of the Investors. This group will meet May 15th at 6:30 p.m.
