NOTE: ALL CLUBHOUSE RENTALS MUST BE PAID BEFORE THE EVENT.

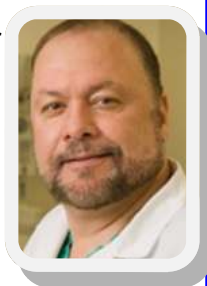
"NEW MEMBERS":

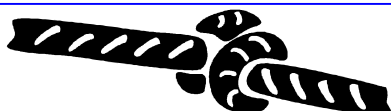

The only way to make sure this does not happen in the future is to get payment up front.

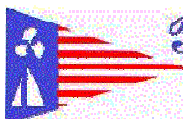
