Notes from Commodore Jeff Hardwick

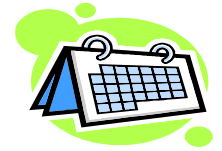


Once again we have had a busy month with a lot of activity and a busy month to come. Our annual banquet was very nice with installation of new members and officers.

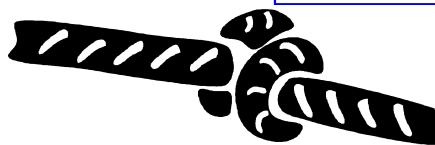
